

## OPERATIONS GEOLOGIST

This position will report directly to the Chief Operating Officer. This position will be responsible for:

- Draft and update geologic prognoses for all approved drilling wells within assigned areas
- Coordinate well permitting and drilling location preparation in cooperation with land, regulatory, drilling and facilities groups
- Provide technical support and quality oversight for wellsite geology processes, including LWD/MWD, wireline logging, coring and directional drilling.
- Geosteer horizontal wells in a 24/7 operation to ensure proper placement of wellbore
- Perform real-time monitoring and interpretation of data acquired while drilling
- Provide expertise for planning, execution and look-back analysis for all wells drilled in the business unit, including but not limited to horizontal wells
- Maintain open communication with VP Exploration and Drilling Engineer during horizontal drilling operations following chain of command
- Maintain a daily reporting system for well operations and data gathering
- Operate and enforce safety practices within the operation complying with company policies, state and federal regulations
- To work with all service providers to create value through safe work procedures, cost effect operations, and service-oriented support.
- To review and research Saturn offset information and peer group performance related to new technologies and industry trends to support best in class operations.
- To provide direct supervision of all field operations.
- To be available after hours and weekends in support of 24/7 operations.
- To be willing to travel throughout Saskatchewan for rig visits as required to support safety and operations audits.

The ideal candidate will possess the following skills and qualifications:

- Willingness to re-locate to Saskatoon corporate headquarters.
- Minimum of 5 years of progressive experience in drilling and completions operations which includes horizontal drilling and multi-stage fracturing.
